Naproxen (aleve)	DO NOT USE IN DOGS		HIGH RISK GI ulcers	DO NOT USE IN DOGS	
Etogesic	mod pain relief for long term conditions	10-15 mg/kg every 24 hr		can cause decrease tear production with serious side effects. Notify vet if signs of eye pain occur and stop using.	
Deramaxx	strongest of the nsaids	3-4 mg/kg/day	is a cox-2 inhibitor	can cause sudden GI bleeding	
Metacam (meloxicam)	cox -2 inhibitor	0.2mg/kg first day, then 0.1 mg/kg every 24 hrs	avail as liquid and pill	can cause GI bleeding	
Carprofen (rimadyl)	cox-2 inhibitor	1 mg/lb every 12 hrs or 2mg/lb every 24 hrs	check blood work before using recheck every 2-4 wks	confirmed cases of liver failure although rare
